LOCATION

AMENITIES

RECORDING & CONFERENCING

Audio and video conferencing are available between rooms or with outside locations. Written instructions for this are attached to the podium and can be found in each classroom.

GSM OFFICE - SUITE 2203

There is one multi-function printer and copier in Room 2203 available for use. This area contains various office and mailing supplies, a refrigerator, and a microwave. - Take the 1st right onto T St.
- Slight right onto Stockton Blvd

- The GSM is the building on the right at the corner of X St. and 48th St.

- Follow I-80 E and US-50 E to 34th St. in Sacramento

PARKING QUICK SHEET

To streamline your parking experience, we recommend using the **Parkmobile App** for purchasing daily parking permits at a cost of \$2.32/day.

1. Create a free Parkmobile account using your @ucdavis.edu email address and register your vehicles (we have provided your email addresses to the parking system).
2. Pay for parking only on the days you require it, ensuring you manually enter the designated zone number: 42201 or 35800/35801 for dual-campus access.
3. If you do not possess a UC Davis email address for ParkMobile registration, you can purchase daily permits using a credit card at the self-service kiosk located in Lot 25, at a rate of \$10 per day. Alternatively, you can use The Flowbird mobile app, also priced at \$10 per day.

Please note that the ticket dispenser in Lot 25, which is situated within the bus shelter (Parking Map attached), will register your license plate number. Daily permits obtained from the dispenser in Lot 25 are valid in Lots 22, 25, 30, Broadway, Contractors, and EDD lots.

Additionally, there is the **JAPA mobile app**, which provides real-time information about available parking spots. You can access the JAPA APP here: [JAPA APP LINK](#).

For those interested in purchasing a UCD Health campus permit online, please follow these steps:

1. Log in to ucdmc.aimsparking.com using your Kerberos ID (same login as UC Path) and DUO authentication.
2. Select "Order Permit" and agree to the Terms of Service.
3. Choose either the GS or GSW Permit, priced at \$85.00 or \$55.00 respectively.
4. Select your desired start date. Please note that permits are sold on a quarterly basis, and you will receive a message indicating an expiration date.
5. Add or select up to three vehicles for your permit, confirming your choices.
6. Add the permit to your cart and proceed to the final checkout screen.

There is no charge for trips around the UC Davis Medical Center campus.

***Important details to note:

- All parking permits are virtual and linked to the License Plate Number.
- While you can attach up to three vehicles to a permit, only one vehicle may be parked on campus at a time.
- Permits are available for purchase on a quarterly basis.
